CEMETERY OWNED BY CREDIFORD HEIRS AND GEORGE COOPER

CREDIFORD CEMETERY RIVER ROAD AT RAILROAD, CROSSING MAP 43, LOT 3 9

Five rows of graves, room for ten (10) in each row.

Row 1--Vague evidence of graves - no stones.

Row 2--Passing from field to woods:2 graves marked, possibly 8 more.

Row 3--Passing from woods to field--5 graves apparent, then SARAH MERRILL, then CHICK (?) marked with stone, next marble, Large stone no inscription, next fieldstone (child?) rest of row probable. marked with stone. Two more probable.

Row 4--NORTH TO SOUTH.-S.E.G. on square

Row 5--SOUTH TO NORTH: (1)JOSEPH GARLAND dec.,July 30, 1858 Age 72 years

(2) ABIGAIL COOPER wife of JOSEPH GARLAND dec. June 5, 1878

age 70 years 2 months 28 days.

(3) DAVID CREDIFORD dec. January 30,,1858 Age 72 years.

(4) MARY M (DOWNING) wife of DAVID CREDIFORD--dec. August 31, 1848 Age 60

(5)&(6) Fieldstones

(7) Stones and SAR marker

(8) Slate, hand carved--MRS RUTH CREDIFORD.

(9) Fieldstone, possible tenth.

ADDITIONAL DATA: ABNER CREDIFORD dec. as early as 1794, having been a private in Revolution. (Son of the JOSEPH who may have been an Indian victim).

SARAH MERRILL, relict of CAPTAIN DANIEL MERRILL, dec. September 11, 1840--Age 86 (cf Kennebunk Gazette and Maine Palladium).

JOSEPH GARLAND, Lived and died on Sinnott House, occupied 1940/50 by KNIGHTS.

ABIGAIL' COOPER, must be child of RUTH 3 ABNER2 JOSEPH' CREDIFORD m. STEPHEN COOPER

DAVID3 (ABNER JOSEPH CREDIFORD) daughter, MRS DORMAN sold to CURRIER 1862, she living in N.H.

Wife of ABNER, RUTH CREDIFORD was grandmother of ANNE PEABODY BROOKS who wrote "Ropers End".

JOSEPH' had land from ancestor SIMON BUSSEY who was killed by Indians.

JOSEPH'S wife was ESTHER LITTLEFIELD, daughter of JOHN LITTLEFIELD.

In 1744-With STORERS group to LOUISBURG c JOHN AND JOSEPH CREDIFORD.
