Sarah Titcomb was a first cousin to H.W. Longfellow. One of the Mitchell men was in the militia in 1812 (possibly Stephen). This information was obtained by Mr. Kehoe (the property owner in 1992) from the Brick Store Museum records. Work began on the Mitchell Cemetery in the summer of 1992 with light clearing and straightening of stones. Daniel's stone was found broken in five pieces with one piece missing in the middle. Heritage Memorials of Sanford determined that the stone was unsalvageable. The stone is stored at the property. Restoration was completed in September 1992.
