Please let me start by thanking you for the trust you've placed in me to serve as your state representative. I understand that the decisions made in Augusta affect each and every Mainer, so I never cast my vote lightly.

The Legislature is currently in the second year of its two-year session and I have resumed my roles on the Transportation Committee and on the Marine Resources Committee. Both of these committees have kept me busy with bills carried over from the first year of this session, as well as those new proposals submitted this year.

One of my top priorities this session has been my goal of reinstating the Circuit Breaker program for our seniors. While both the bill and a subsequent amendment I proposed were defeated along party lines, I have not given up on this goal. As a taxpayer in Arundel myself, I am aware of the high taxes we pay and I believe we must be protecting our low-income homeowners, especially our seniors on fixed incomes. In addition, I know how difficult it is when the state doesn't keep its promises and pushes things off onto the towns. I have always promised to be the voice of the taxpayer and I will continue to do that by advocating for Augusta to better prioritize its spending.
