An additional stone in the middle of the cemetery (on a mound of land and set horizontally on a concrete base) reads as follows:

In memory of Thomas Durell, Esq.  
Who died  
September 7, 1809  
AE 57  
When I lie buryd deep in dust,  
My flesh shall be thy care,  
These withering limbs with thee I trust,  
To raise them strong and fair.

Cemetery was found in good condition, all stones standing, in the summer of 1990.
