I. Public Hearing at 175 Maplewood Drive


Item 1: **Good Tern Brewing Company: Administrative Conditional Use Application// Home Occupation: Determination of Completeness:** Proposal to operate a micro-brewery for production only in a 292.5 square foot outbuilding located on a residential property at 175 Maplewood Drive, Tax Map 17, Lot 14-45 in the R-1 district. Dylan Post is the owner and applicant.

The applicant Dylan Post stated that he had contacted most of his neighbors regarding his proposed application and had concluded that the proposed operation would be detrimental to neighborhood cohesiveness. Therefore Mr. Post respectfully rescinded his Home Occupation application for the Good Tern Brewing Company.
