**PUBLIC HEARING Discussion on Question #1 which will appear as a Referendum Question at the November 8, 2016 Election. "Shall Fluoride be added to the public water supply for the intended purpose of reducing tooth decay?"** Chairman Hayes opened the Hearing at 7PM. Presently Fluoride is added to the Public Water Supply. The vote is a District Wide Vote and a majority of the district will prevail. Petitioners who asked for this question wish to have the Fluoride removed from the water as it presently is added. Many folks spoke for and against adding fluoride. Hearing closed @ 7:19PM.

**PUBLIC HEARING Discussion on renewal of Automobile Graveyard/Junkyard Permits for AIM Recycling USA, LLC d/b/a AIM Recycling Arundel and Marcel Dubois d/b/a Dubois Motors.** Chairman Hayes opened hearing @ 7:20PM no questions hearing was closed @ 7:21PM.

**I. Call to Order**

Chair Velma Jones Hayes called the regular meeting to order at 7:21 p.m. and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**II. Approval of Agenda**

Motion was made by Dubois seconded by Nedeau to approve the agenda with the following additions: Boards & Committees – Planning Board

Motion to approve the agenda as amended carried 5-0.

**III. Public Forum** – Mr. John derKinderen read a statement as it related to enforcement issues for Brookside Estates

**IV. Approve minutes of September 12, 2016**

Motion was made by Dubois seconded by Labbe to approve the minutes of September 12, 2016 as written. Motion carried 5-0.

**V. Committee and Board Reports**

**A. Planning Board Update:** Selectmen Dubois provided the BOS members a review of the matters being addressed by the Planning Board.

**VI. Manager's Report**

**A. Bartlett Bridge Meeting:** Bridge Construction set for June – November 2017. Temporary 2-way Bridge will be installed. Town discussed the realignment of Walkers Lane to Route #1 and sleeve under bridge for possible sewer line.

## VII. Old Business

- A. Public Forum 9/19/2016:** Based on the public comments on the 19<sup>th</sup> the Board of Selectmen will be sending the request for another Sheriff Patrol Deputy onto the Budget Committee for comments. If the Selectmen decide to add it onto the ATM Warrant. It will be presented as a separate warrant article for consideration
- B. Transfer Station Container:** Review of Bids by staff, staff recommends low bid. MOTION Dubois second Danylik "approve bid from East Coast Container for \$6,200" passed 5-0.
- C. Brush Truck Purchase:** Fire Chief provided a memo recommending low bid from IPS for \$115,755.00. MOTION Dubois second Labbe "approve low Bid from IPS for \$115,755.00 provided other equipment built by IPS is viewed for quality and meets the Fire Department Standard and that the necessary funding within the Utility Safety TIF for this purchase is in order" passed 4-0-1 (Nedeau).

## VIII. New Business

- A. Renewal of Automobile Graveyard/Junkyard Permits:** MOTION Dubois second Danylik "approve and sign the renewal permit for AIM Recycling Arundel" passed 5-0. MOTION Labbe second Dubois approve and sign renewal permit for Dubois Motors" passed 5-0.
- B. Payroll & Payable Warrants:** MOTION Nedeau second Labbe "approve payroll and payable warrants as presented and reviewed" passed 5-0.

## IX. Other Business and Adjournment

The Board discussed the Public Forum statement read by Mr. deKinderen. Question was raised on the Planning Boards ability to revoke a permit if findings of fact are not followed. They also asked the Town Manager and CEO to provide an understanding into their involvement into the enforcement of this matter.

Motion was duly made by Dubois seconded by Labbe to adjourn at 8:22 pm. Motion carried 5-0.
