

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT REPORT

The winter season of 2013-2014 will be remembered for its severe cold as well as its abundance of snow. We have responded to 42 calls and have used 1875 yards of sand, 509 tons of salt, and 1007 gallons of liquid calcium this season.

Last year's paving projects included a section of Mountain Road, New Road, Curtis Road, and a section of the Sinnott Road. Several large culverts were relined instead of complete replacement, which saves time and money.

This year's paving projects include a section of the River Road from the railroad tracks to Durrell's Bridge Road; a section of the Thompson Road will be reclaimed and paved; North Skilling's Road is scheduled for a shim and overlay; and the Proctor Road will have some reclaiming and paving on a short section. More culvert relining is also on the schedule.
