

PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE TOWN OF ARUNDEL

To protect our residents and employees and to slow the spread of diseases such as COVID-19 and Seasonal Flu in the community at large, we ask that you follow the CDC guidelines listed below.

COVID-19 and/or the seasonal flu may present the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

If you are sick with COVID-19 or suspect you are infected with the COVID-19 virus, STAY AT HOME, EXCEPT TO SEEK MEDICAL CARE.

DO NOT GO TO WORK, SCHOOL, OR PUBLIC AREAS (SUCH AS THE TOWN HALL, LIBRARY, AND OTHER PUBLIC BUILDINGS). AVOID USING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, RIDE-SHARING, OR TAXIS.

Out of an abundance of caution, the Town has cancelled all scheduled social programs and social events until further notice. At this time (03/13/20) official meetings of Town Boards and Committees will continue as scheduled. Many meetings are broadcast on time delay on you tube and the town will make efforts to provide draft minutes on line as soon as possible after meetings.

If you are unable to visit Town facilities due to illness, there are many on-line services available for Auto/Trailer Registration, Hunting & Fishing, Boats & Dog Licenses to name a few.
