Inscribed with the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm
4. LYDIA THOMPSON DIED May 12, 1879, AE. 83 yrs. 7 mos.
5. JOSEPH THOMPSON
6. (no stone)

Row 2

1. CAPT. JAMES THOMPSON DIED \_\_\_17\_, AE. 85 yrs. 5 mos. & 26 days.
2. ANNA, wife of Capt. James Thompson, DIED 17\_\_\_, AE. 79 yrs. 8 mos. & 16 days.
3. MARY WALKER DIED November 1792, AE. 80 yrs.
5. JOSEPH WALKER DIED May 1779, AE. 75 yrs. (or 73 yrs.)
5. (stone base, no stone)
6. (no stone)
