Row 1

1. unmarked fieldstone with footstone of the same

Row 2

1. broken stone, no writing on remaining piece
2. CHARLES WAKEFIELD, DIED Feb. 7, 1849, AE. 25 yrs.

To push us to the tomb,
And fierce diseases wait around
To hurry mortals home.
3. SALLY, wife of James Wakefield, DIED Mar. 6, 1829, AE. 31 yrs.
